Venue: Language Lab.


LEAD club, the Language Enhancement and Development club of RGIT, organized the first ever parliamentary debate competition of RGIT on the 31st of January, 2023.

3. Stage play on the life of Chattrapati Shivaji Maharaj by Mukhavte


The whole event was hosted by LEAD club members and that too in Marathi. This was an event to support various languages in the country and feel pride towards Indian languages and culture.
