Sir discussed two aspects in his presentation. One Cultural aspects while working across world and second aspects of US education system.

In Japan commitment is commitment. They never get delayed. They don't import. They decide what is launch date and people work backward and they never get delayed. They complete project in time.

Sir discussed German people's approach, detailed, methodical and persistent. Though the German people are advanced, they leave within their means.

In US people dream big, they do not think this is possible or not. They dream big and figure out how something like this could be done. Sir explained the example of pipeline that was broken during war and how they overcome it.

Sir discussed some aspects of US education system. What he has seen in US is that there is lot of emphasis on experiential learning and holistic learning. They try out lot of things. There is no emphasis on memorizing.

Finally, second session ended with vote of thanks proposed by Prof. Nazahat Balur followed by national anthem.

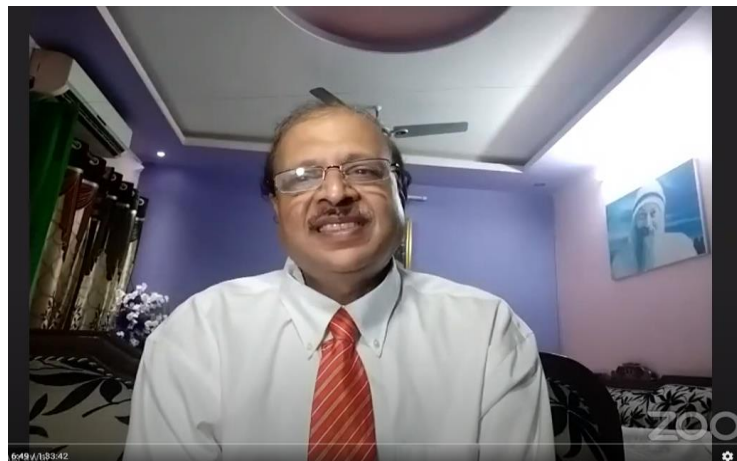

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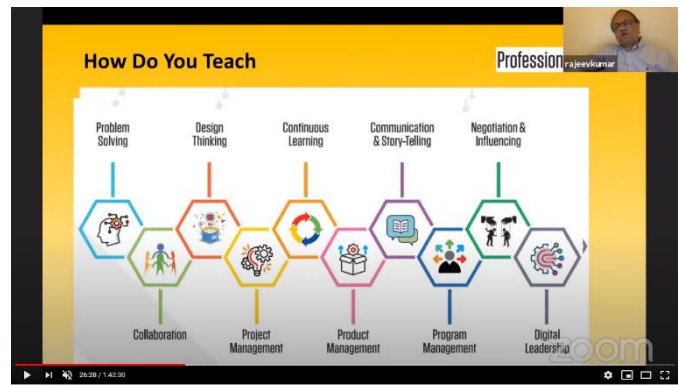
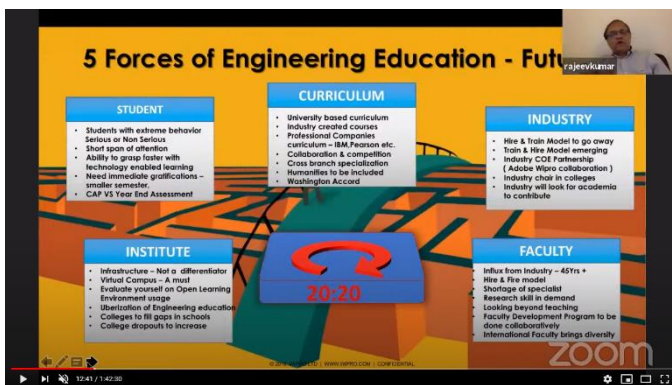
Sir said India has the second largest pool of STEM talent in the world. Sir said disruption have always created new job. According to Economic Forum, more than 75 million jobs may be lost as companies shift to more on automation. But 133 million new jobs will also emerge as business develop new division of labour between people and machines. Finally, Inaugural function and first session ended with vote of thanks proposed by Prof. Kishor G. Sawarkar.

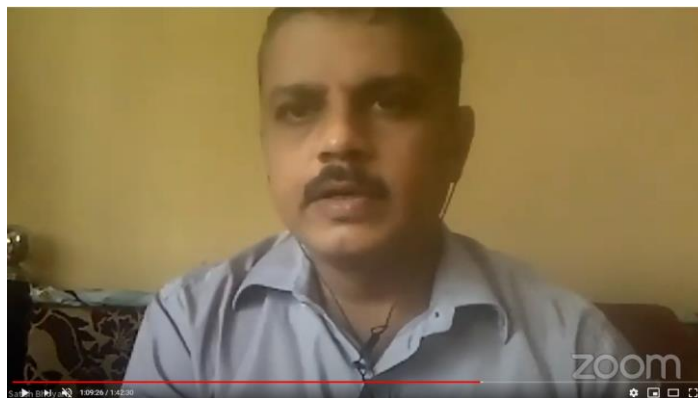

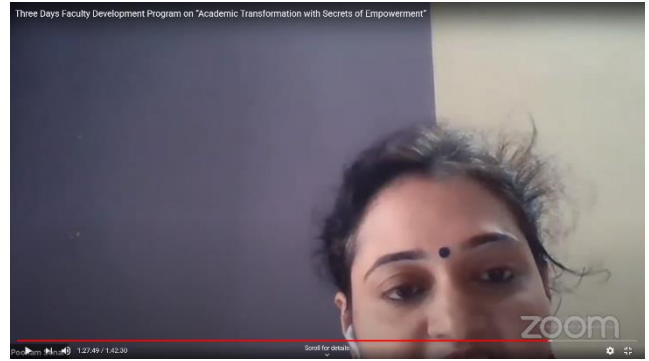
